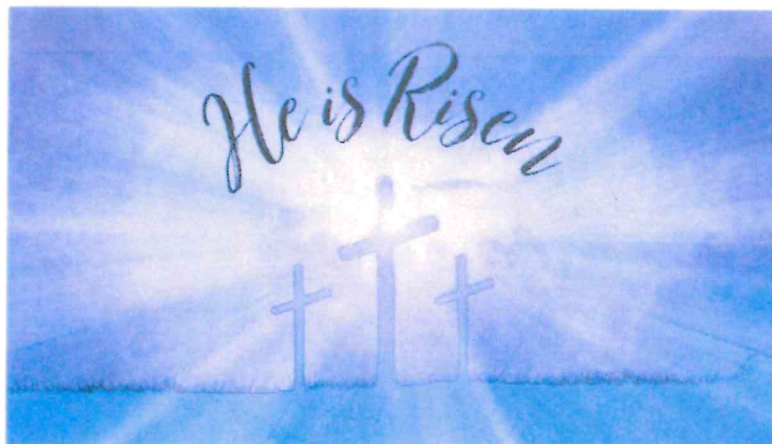




NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL
