1 9x12 Sketchbook Spiral or Bound	<p>Instrument: A Concert Band has the following instruments for your son or daughter to choose from: flute, clarinet, alto, tenor, or bari sax, trombone, trumpet, french horn, tuba, euphonium, oboe, bassoon, snare drum, bass drum, and pitched percussion (glockenspiel, xylophone, marimba). Each student is responsible to rent or purchase their instrument on their own. (except percussion)</p> <p>If your child plays guitar or keyboard, please be open to considering a different instrument that aligns with a Concert Band's instrumentation. (percussion, flute, clarinet, etc). We will discuss these challenges openly in class as we begin the year.</p>	2 Pocket Folder for chorus	<p>Instrument: Violin, Viola, Cello and Bass are the instruments your son or daughter can choose from for Strings Class. These instruments come in many sizes, and it is important that the size of the instrument matches the size of the student. Please be sure to get a music teacher to measure your child for the appropriate size instrument before you purchase an instrument.</p>
2 Pencils	<p>ALL STUDENTS will need "Standard of Excellence, Book 1" by Bruce Pearson. This is a very important daily workbook/homework method book for each musician. Please purchase the book that aligns with your child's instrument at jwpepper.com for \$6.95 each plus shipping. This will help support the instrument on the body. Artino, Kun, and shaped shoulder sponges are all acceptable. • Cello & Bass students will need an end pin anchor. This will help stabilize the instrument's end pin on the floor so that it does not slip. End pin anchors with a strap that can be attached to the leg of a chair are recommended. An example of this type is the Xeros Brand. End pin anchors without a strap are also acceptable options.
1 Eraser	Reeds: Wind instruments such as clarinet,	Index Cards	Rosin
