

Grade 2 December Goals 2019

Reading

We will identify the main idea of a text/paragraph and draw conclusions including supporting details.

We will identify the facts, opinions and text and graphic features used in an informational text.

Writing

We will continue to write explanatory texts telling the reader "how to" make or do something.

We will begin to write informative texts in which we will introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop an "All About Book".

We will use research to gather information on various animals found in non-fiction texts, online resources and articles.

Math

We will use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve one- and two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing.

We will be able to add and subtract using strategies based on place value and properties of operations.

Science

We will continue to learn about plant and animal relationships.

Social Studies

We will be doing a comparative study while learning about what life is like in urban, suburban, and rural communities. Students will compare and contrast these communities on their own. They will use multiple resources to gather information about different types of communities. As a culminating project, students will create a diorama of a chosen community.
