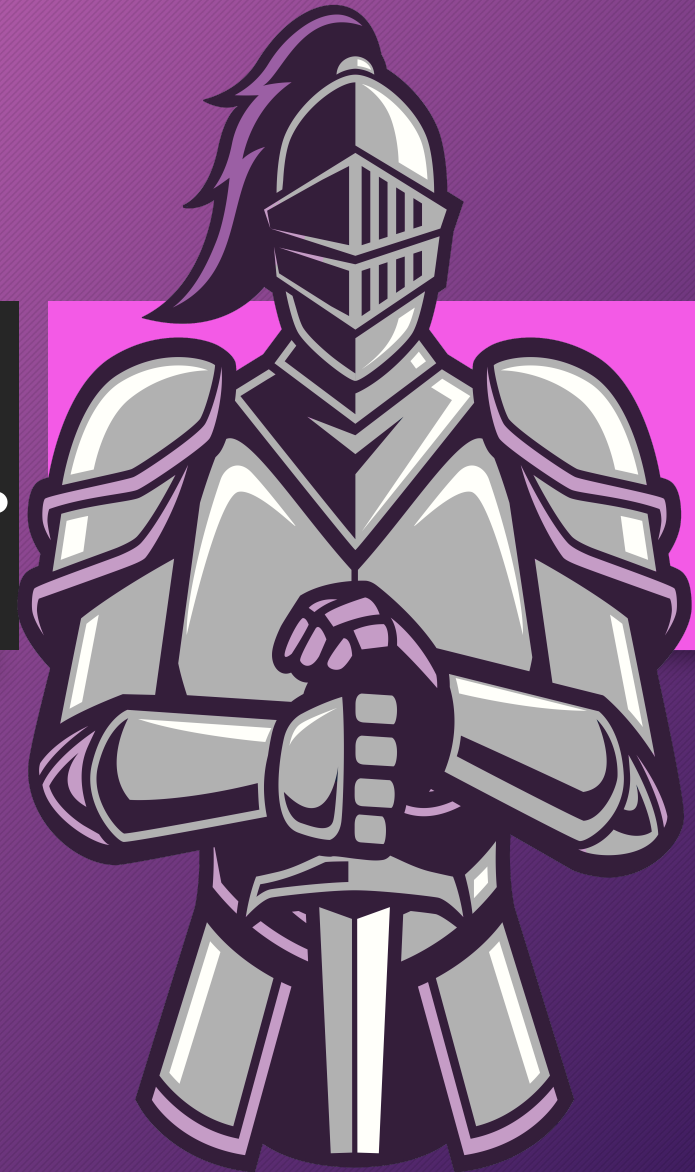


It's your Digital Library Card.

Your Digital Library Card:

- This card will allow you to check out thousands of books, magazines, and audiobooks for three weeks at a time. The item(s) you have checked out will automatically return in 3 weeks and there are never any fines for digital items!
- The **Georgia Download Destination** digital library is brought to you through a partnership between ULHS and Pine Mountain Regional Library and Hightower Memorial Library.

What else can I access through the Georgia Download Destination?



Georgia Library Learning Online (GALILEO) is an online library portal filled with over 100 databases indexing thousands of periodicals and scholarly journals. The portal also contains encyclopedias, government publications, and many other resources.

This includes resources such as:



Learning Express Library is an online learning platform with over 770 practice tests, tutorials, and eBooks related to job search and workplace skills improvement, career certification and licensing exam preparation, college entrance and graduate school admissions exam preparation, GED exam preparation, and basic skills improvement in reading, writing, and math, for all ages.



Mángo Languages offers access to 60 foreign language courses and 17 English courses taught in the user's native language. Mango teaches vocabulary, pronunciation, grammar, and culture all in one integrated experience.



Academic Search Complete is a multi-disciplinary database, with more than 6,100 full-text periodicals, including more than 5,100 peer-reviewed journals all covering information in areas of academic study.

These include archaeology, biology, chemistry, engineering, food science, law, music, psychology, religion, women's studies, and many others.



Virtual Chemistry Lab, or the Chemistry Collective, provides scenario-based learning activities for in-class or homework assignments for students.

You can access GALILEO through the link on our library website at www.pinemtnlibrary.org.

Once you are on GALILEO, click on the Databases A to Z to browse all databases.

GALILEO access outside of the library requires a one-word password that is updated every 6 months. Call any of our library locations to acquire the most current password.

What else can I access?

Read to yourself, look at magazines, check out videos, newspapers, and biographies on GALILEO; listen to audiobooks, or read to your little brothers and sisters using e-read kids. 😊



eRead Kids is provided by the Georgia Public Library Service and is a large collection of free eBooks and eAudiobooks. This service has a selection of both fiction and non-fiction titles that can be downloaded to your device.

To access eRead Kids, go to pinemountain.axis360.baker-taylor.com and login with your library card number and your PIN.



Your library card grants you access to free eBooks and eAudiobooks through the library with Overdrive through the Libby App!

Items check out for up to 3 weeks at a time and will return themselves when they are due. There are no late fees or charges!

If you find items that are currently checked out, you can place them on hold and you will be notified when they become available for you to download!

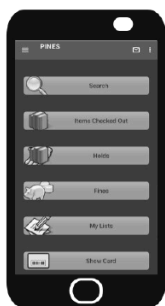
To Access Your Account:

- 1) Just download the Libby App from your App Store

- 3) Log in with your Library Card Number and your PIN

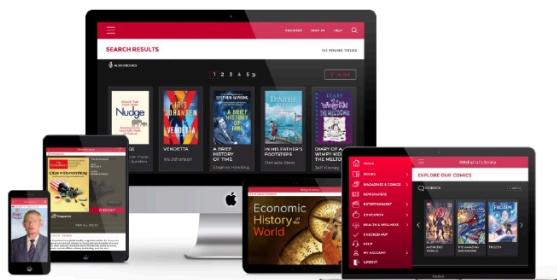
Your Digital Library Card is a unique doorway to tons of great services.

Your Digital Library Card

You should have received a library card number and a PIN (which should be the last four digits of your phone number—(unless it has changed)). Please make sure than you have written this PIN down and don't lose it. It is not printed on your card like your library number is.

Yes, you can download the Libby App to your phone and download a book to your device so that it is available in places where you don't have internet. Here are some options.



How to Use Overdrive and Libby



First, what device are you using?

I use an iPad/iPhone/Android smartphone or tablet



The Libby app downloaded from your app store



Download eBooks and audiobooks to enjoy offline



1. Download the Libby app in the app store
2. Search for Georgia Download Destination
3. Enter your library card number
4. Browse and borrow!

To update your download preferences, click on "Actions" then "Change Download Rules" when viewing your shelf

I use a Chromebook/laptop/desktop computer

Okay! Then you'll use...

Libbyapp.com in your internet browser

You will be able to:

Read or listen on WiFi only

How do I get started?

1. Go to libbyapp.com
2. Search for Georgia Download Destination
3. Enter your library card number
4. Browse and borrow!

I use a Kindle Fire (has apps)

The Overdrive app downloaded from your Kindle app store

Download eBooks and audiobooks to enjoy offline

1. Download the Overdrive app in the app store
2. Search for your library
3. Enter your library card number
4. Browse and borrow!

To return items early, look for "Files" in the menu. Scroll to the end of the list and choose "Delete All"

I use a Kindle e-reader (including the Paperwhite and Oasis)



Libbyapp.com to send books to your device through your Amazon account



Read eBooks only (audiobooks not available for these devices)



1. Go to libbyapp.com and set up your account
2. Browse and borrow
3. View items on "Shelf"
4. Choose "Read with..." then "Kindle" next to the item
5. You will be directed to your Amazon account to log in and send the item to your Kindle device

Remember, your items will **check out for 3 weeks.**
