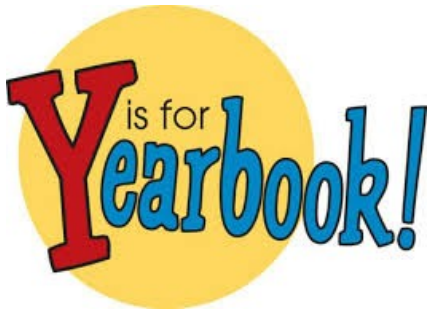
During last year's Fun Run and previous Walk-a-Thons, we were able to offer Cross Fit, Polynesian and Latin dance, martial arts and so much more.

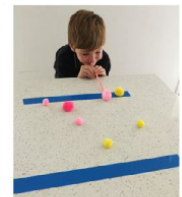


## Min-It-To-Win-It
