The Mathematics Department at Shelton High School has finalized its summer work requirements for 2023. All core courses (Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2) and many other courses in the department have required or recommended summer work. The work is reviewed by the department each year to ensure that it is a meaningful way for students to practice math skills in the summer and arrive well-prepared for their next math course at Shelton High School.

The summer math requirements for students in Grades 9-12 depend on the course they are registered for next year. Each packet details the assignment to be completed.

The most meaningful way to complete this work is throughout the course of the summer for continual practice and review. Students are encouraged to choose technological tools strategically when working on the assignment. For example, while using a math website or app is an excellent strategy to learn how to complete a problem or to check an answer, using math software or apps to complete the entire assignment without learning defeats the purpose of the work.
