- Board option to reduce the required number of educator contract days by the amount of 3 attendance days due to Inclement weather that required closing of Elementary and High School campuses.

An emergency or urgent public necessity exists that requires immediate action of the Board or an imminent threat to public health and safety or a reasonably unforeseeable situation exists, as follows:

1-2 The flooding that occurred in Polk County 4/29/24 - 5/02/24 that affected the safe transport of students and staff required school closures that resulted in the need for immediate waivers to meet required minutes of 75,600 since the scheduled May meeting would be too late for action.

If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the board will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapters D and E or Texas Government Code section 418.183(f). Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting. [See TASB Policy BEC(LEGAL)]
