2016-2017 Meal Purchasing Policy – Groom ISD

- 1) Meal Prices are set by the Board upon recommendation of the administration. Factors influencing meal prices include:
 - 1) current USDA reimbursement rates for meals,
 - 2) cost of food, and
 - 3) cafeteria overhead expenses.

2) Charge Policy (Accounts with a \$0 Balance):

- A. Students will be allowed to charge meals or other food items up to a maximum of \$20.00 {Approximately 5 days of meals}
 - (Exception students with delinquent balances from former years will not be allowed to charge meals),
- B. Upon reaching the \$20.00 charge limit students will be offered alternative meals until the account has a positive balance (No child will go hungry),
- C. Alternative meals will be charged at a cost-basis rate only,
- D. After reaching the charge limit, without payment of the account, the student account will become "cash basis only" meaning that the student will be served cafeteria meals only on a cash pay basis which means to have a positive account balance or cash in hand (they will remain eligible for alternative meals if necessary),
- E. The account will stay on a "cash basis only" status, meaning no charges, until it has a positive balance of at least \$20.00. Students will be served meals at any time they have a positive balance in the account; however, the ability to charge lunches will not be restored until the account reaches the desired minimum positive balance.

3) Parent Notices

- A. Notices will be mailed to the official address of the students' parent or guardian on file with the district at the following intervals:
 - Low Balance Notice when the account reaches \$25.00 (7 days of Full Meals)
 - Notice when the account reaches \$10.00 (3 Days of Full Meals)
 - Charge Limit Notice/Alternative Meal Notice when the account reaches a negative balance of \$10.00. (3 Days of Full Meal Charges Remaining)
- B. Parents may set additional account balance thresholds for notification within the "My School Bucks" web portal at www.myschoolbucks.org. This software allows for balance notifications by e-mail and/or text.

4) Former Year(s) – Delinquent Accounts

- a. Delinquent Accounts Meal accounts will be considered delinquent when payment in full is not received by August 1 following the school year,
- The online payment portal can be utilized to place money on a student's account for the <u>CURRENT school year only</u> – families owing money from a prior year must submit those payments directly to the school business office,
- c. NO CHARGE POLICY DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS CASH ONLY BASIS

Effective August 22, 2016 – Students with delinquent meal accounts from prior years will not be allowed to charge meals in the current year – they will be served meals only with a positive balance in their current account. These students will be eligible for alternative meals should their account reach have ZERO balance in the current year.

Final account balance notices will be mailed to parents/guardians by June 15 following the completion of the school year. Refunds due to parents will be processed at that time.

Bills paid by August 1 following the school year will not be considered delinquent.

Additional Notice of an Unpaid Account Balance will be mailed to parents/guardians by July 15 following the school year.
