As you know we are in full-remote learning mode this week, January 4 through 8. Next Monday, January 11, we will return to our traditional/digital mode with students in the building and learning at home. For "digital" students, there will no longer be a digital check-in email from Mrs. Inglese. Students that are learning at home must log-on to homeroom each day for attendance. Very much like the remote plan we are on now, digital students must log into homeroom by 8:05 am or be marked absent.

It is no longer necessary for parents to contact us and alert us to Fiona's placement on the digital or traditional plan. If he/she is in school on time, he/she will be marked present. If he/she logs in digitally by 8:05 am, he/she will be marked online present. Otherwise, Fiona will be marked absent.

Semester Change

Thursday January 14 is the end of the 1st semester. Student schedules will change for the 2nd semester on Friday January 15. Students' core classes (Math, ELA, Science, & Social Studies) will not change, only specials, such as Computers, Art, Music, and Phys Ed will change. Every student will receive an updated schedule in homeroom on January 12. Your child's schedule for the 3rd quarter will be listed.
