INSTRUCTIONAL UPDATES

- **TIER I INTERVISITATIONS:** Tier I principals have opened-up their doors to share best practices with all principals in the district.
- **MATH COLLABORATIVE:** D23 is now working with the Math Collaborative team from Central to provide support through coaching, intervisitations, and workshops for teachers and principals.
- **RELAY GSE** is providing leadership coaching for two schools in the district.
- **AIM:** Cohort I met today at BCMS, Cohorts II & III will meet this month.
- **REGENTS PREP:** Middle Schools are currently working with Dr. George Leonard to ensure our 8th grade students take the regents exam and pass with high scores.
- **iREADY:** Testing for middle of the year (MOY) is underway.



INSTRUCTIONAL UPDATES

- **DYSLEXIA PILOT:** We are moving into Round II of the Dyslexia Pilot. Four new schools will receive support for Dyslexia screening.
- **ROUND II INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT:** Our Round I instructional support is coming to a close. Schools that have not received direct district support will receive targeted support during Round II.
- **ZEARN:** Zearn's digital teaching and learning tools reinforce core grade-level math concepts while providing in-the-moment support for each student. Students who used Zearn Math grew state math scores 2.5 times more than matched students who did not use Zearn Math.
- **AMIRA:** Amira is an AI tutor in a game that is proven to double the pace of reading growth for children ages 5 to 10. Amira recommends appropriately challenging stories, listens as a student reads aloud, and intervenes when helpful.
