Queens Gateway to Health Sciences Secondary School is an AP CAPSTONE/AP For All school. It was founded in 1994. We are a grade 6-12 Screened school, offering our students' unique collaborative programs with St. Johns University, LIU, CUNY and the LIU High Schools Scholars Program. As part of these academic partnerships, our students are provided with undergraduate student teachers, faculty mentors for AP courses, and academic support for our special needs population. Our AP Capstone Scholars program offers our high school students the distinctive opportunity, to earn a diploma through a 2 year long course of study. We have sophisticated Science Labs, Lecture Theater styled Auditorium and Automated Research Library System. We have a collaborative partnership with Queens Hospital Center. Some of the highlights of this partnership, include mentorship opportunities throughout the hospital and in house presentations and workshops. Queens Gateway consistently enjoys a national recognition for its exemplary reputation for AP Capstone Research. Our students also publish their research in Academic Research. In addition, we are a WISE Financial Literacy Blue star school. CUNY College NOW and STEP-STEM programs are available. In our Middle School our Grade 8 students are enrolled in Accelerated (REGENTS) programs: US History, Living Environment, Algebra I and Spanish. In our High School student are offered 18 Advanced Placement Courses.

As a result of our academic rigor, our graduation rates are at 98.7% leading to a College Grade 4yr rate of 97.8%.
