In an effort to make bringing classroom supplies to school easier, we have spaced the dates that items are due. Please note that all supplies are due to the classroom no later than Wednesday, September 13th. These supplies are important to our classroom community as well as your child's work in the classroom.

□ 3 marble notebooks labeled with your child's name
□ 1 RED HARD, PLASTIC pocket folders labeled with your child's name
□ 1 BLUE HARD, PLASTIC pocket folders labeled with your child's name
\Box 1 GREEN HARD, PLASTIC pocket folders labeled with your child's name
□ 1 YELLOW HARD, PLASTIC pocket folders labeled with your child's name
□ 1 ORANGE HARD, PLASTIC pocket folders labeled with your child's name
□ 48 Ticonderoga SHARPENED pencils (The Staples brand or the Dollar store break- please do not
buy them)
□ 1 box of 16 Crayola crayons
\Box 1 box of sharpened colored pencils
□ \$5.00 in a sealed envelope with your child's name – for erasers and book baggies
\Box scissors
\Box soft shelled pencil cases that can hold small supplies (pencils, glue, scissors, etc.) labeled with
your child's name
□ pencil sharpener

□ 2 packs of at least 8 thick black dry erase Expo markers
\Box 2 packs of glue sticks (Avery or Elmer's brand)
\Box 1 pack of 3x3 post-its with lines
\Box 1 package of white copy paper (500 sheets)
\Box 2 rolls of paper towels

\Box 2 boxes of tissues
□ headphones (no earbuds)
□ 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags (Only BOYS need to bring this item)
\Box 1 box of sandwich size Ziploc bags (Only GIRLS need to bring this item)
□ 3 containers of Lysol disinfectant wipes
□ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer and 1 hand soap
□ 3 stretchable book covers for textbooks
