SCHOOL HOURS	School begins every day at 8:10 a.m. Children are marked late at 8:11 a.m. Late students will be give
	a late pass to submit to their teacher. Students are dismissed at 2:30 p.m. every day.
NIFORM CODE	P.S./I.S. 208 is a uniform school. All students are to wear dark pants/skirts and light blue tops for Grades 5 to 8 and white tops for Grades K to 4. <b>NO SNEAKERS ARE PERMITTED</b> . Only lower grade students may wear sneakers on their Gym days.
BUS SERVICE	Yellow bus service is provided for all students in Grades K to 6. Children in Grades 7 and 8 will be issued Metro Cards. Parents should always know the name of their child's bus company, as well as A.N. and P.M. route numbers. Call your respective bus company in the event of delays.
CHOOL COSINGS	In the event of inclement weather you can call 311 to see if schools are open. The news channels are also informed of school delays or closings—generally before 6 a.m.
