Being a student in good standing at Central High School; I agree to the following provisions:

- ✓ All vehicles parked on campus during school hours must display a parking permit. **Permit must be displayed in full view on rearview mirror.** Parking permits may not be altered in any way.
- ✓ I agree to maintain current insurance and registration on the vehicle.
- ✓ I will respect the speed limit of 10 miles per hour at all times and drive in a safe and courteous manner.
- ✓ I will comply with all laws of the California Motor Vehicle Code and all rules governing driving and parking on campus at all times.
- ✓ I understand that all vehicles are parked at my own risk. Central High School and/or the Central Unified High School District is/are not responsible for damage or loss to my vehicle as a result of parking on campus.
- ✓ I will park only in student designated parking stalls and within the provided parking space.
- ✓ I will follow and obey all instructions from CHS Administration, Campus Supervisors and Police.
- ✓ If I arrive late to school and the student parking lot gates are locked, I will check-in with the front office and a liaison will be called to unlock the gate.
- ✓ I will not park anywhere along the access road (fire lane) around the school or in a red zone.
- ✓ I will not park in staff parking lot or designated staff parking spaces (yellow painted spaces) between the hours of 6:45 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- ✓ Student parking permits are non-transferable and must be renewed each school year.
- ✓ All parking and traffic regulations are enforced by Central High School and the Fresno Police.
- ✓ A parking permit does not guarantee a parking space. Parking is on a first-come basis. If there is no parking available, you must park off campus and at your own risk.
- ✓ I understand that the issued parking permit is only for the vehicle listed above. Giving my permit to another individual to use is a violation of this agreement and will result in a citation.
- ✓ A citation may be issued for all and/or any infraction. All vehicles are subject to search by school officials or police.

*I, the undersigned, hereby agree to the parking and driving rules regulations above and understand that if I do not comply with these expectations, I will be subject to:*

- revocation of the Central High School issued parking permit;
- a loss of school privileges which may include (depending on severity):
  - early release privilege,
  - off campus privilege,
  - extracurricular activities (including all senior activities),
  - detention,
  - Saturday school,
  - suspension and/or recommendation for transfer to alternative placement
  - referral of the driver/owner of car to Fresno Police Department
