

*Below is a complete list of supplies required in all major subject areas. We ask that students come to school fully prepared and organized for each class daily.*

### **English Department Supply List 2016-2017**

*The following are a list of items that will be collected by their English Language Arts teacher:*

#### **6th and 7th Grade:**

- 3 marble notebooks
- 2 two-pocket folders (one red/ one green)
- 1 package of lined post-its
- 1 package of loose-leaf
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 two-gallon Ziploc bags
- 1 roll of scotch tape
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of tissues

#### **8th Grade**

- 4 marble notebooks
- 2 two-pocket folders (one red/ one green)
- 1 package of post-its
- 1 package of loose-leaf
- 2 reams of white copy paper
- 1 roll of scotch tape
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of tissues
- Colored pencils

In addition to the supplies above, students are asked to be prepared everyday with the following supplies that they will carry with them:

- Pens, Pencils
- Highlighters
- Mini-dictionary/thesaurus

### **Math Department Supply List for 2016-2017**

- Students are to use a section in their binder for math
- 1 – 3 hole-punched folder (with two interior pockets to organize handouts and notices)
- 1 package of looseleaf - ***FOR HOME USE – DO NOT BRING TO SCHOOL***
- 1 ream of computer paper
- Clear plastic 6-inch Ruler - ***FOR HOME USE- DO NOT BRING TO SCHOOL***
- Clear plastic 4-inch Protractor- ***FOR HOME USE- DO NOT BRING TO SCHOOL***
- Scientific Calculator – ***FOR HOME USE - DO NOT BRING TO SCHOOL***
- 1 box (of 12) pencils with erasers
- Pencil sharpener
- 1 package of **dry erase** crayons **or** markers
- A box of tissues and paper towels (**These items are optional, but are greatly appreciated.**)

Students are expected to come prepared each day with the following supplies:

1. Sharpened pencils with erasers
2. Their binder with loose leaf paper, including the current work and folder

Many of the supplies listed above will be collected by the classroom teacher and used as needed throughout the school year. ***Your cooperation and support of our classrooms is much needed and greatly appreciated.***

**\*\*Please keep in mind that all students will need a scientific calculator, 4-inch plastic protractor and a 6-inch plastic ruler for use at home. These supplies will be provided by the teacher for in school, classroom use.\*\***

### **Science Department Supply List**

- 1 package of loose leaf paper
- 1 ream of white copy paper

### **Social Studies Department Supply List**

- 1 ream of copy paper
- 1 pack of loose-leaf paper (8” x 10 ½ “, wide-ruled), unopened
- 1 Folder (with two interior pockets to organize handouts and notices)
- 2 packs of Post-It Notes
- 2 Highlighters (in different colors)
- 1 box of tissues (this item is optional, but greatly appreciated).

Students are expected to come in each day with the following supplies:

1. Writing Utensils (pens preferred)
2. Binder with adequate loose-leaf for daily use (to be used for other subjects as well) for notes, handouts, etc.
3. A Folder
