## **CALENDAR MEETING**

Call to order by Ms. Asiedu at 6:12 pm. Attendance and roll call was taken. We do not have quorum at 6:12pm.

**Presenters:** Sharon Rencher: Senior Advisor to the Chancellor/ Senior Executive Director State/ Federal Education Policy and School Improvement Programs

Olivia Ellis: Director of Community Engagement and School Support, Office of School Support

Ms. Rencher spoke about the School Improvement Federal Grant (SIFG) / School Innovation Grant (SIG) tied into the Title 1 funding stream. See attached power point. The DOE would be receiving 2.5 million over the next 5 years, giving the selected schools, \$500,000 per school. This Federal Program has 2 models: Family and Community or Career and College. This summer of June 30<sup>th</sup>, all 1800 schools submitted their S/CEP plans. The DOE reviewed their plans and give feedback to improve on student outcomes. Our districts also have a DCEP plans focusing on their district's goals similar to the S/CEP plans.

There are issues with DLT meetings since they focus on K-8 schools and not high schools. They plan to have focus groups with HS parents and their HS Superintendents, to see if this would be workable relationship. If this model is successful, they would branch out and create similar groups in all the districts. Members have problems with DLT meetings. This fall Ms. Rencher would be addressing the DLT issues along with FACE Executive Superintendent Yolanda Torres.

Ms. Rencher focuses on the reauthorization of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Most of the ESSA programs are applicable to New York City. The timeline for the ESSA is: 2015-16 is the bill passage and initial rule making, 2016-17 is the transition year and 2017-18 is when the new systems are in place. Under this new bill, there is great importance placed on Parent and Family Engagement with outreach made to this group, and they will have 4 months to respond accordingly. Parents are the key components of this education plan. Some of the details of this plan were discussed.
