CMP's Student Health and Safety Policy

Many children have already been sick this year. Below are a few reminders of CMP's policy to keep everyone as healthy and safe as possible.

The following is a summary of health guidelines that the school is required to abide by:

1. It is the policy of The California Montessori Project to allow students to attend school when they have minor allergies.
2. Any contagious illnesses and/or a fever of 100°F or higher require the student to be absent from school. **The child must remain fever-free for twenty-four hours prior to returning to school.** Contagious illnesses require that the student has been on an approved course of medication for at least twenty-four hours prior to returning to school along with a doctor's note indicating that the student is no longer contagious and is ready to return to school. Please be conscious of these policies and take the other children and staff into consideration in this regard.

Medication:

1. When any prescribed medication needs to be given to a child, the school must have written permission and instructions from the parent and the child's doctor before school staff can administer the medication. A Medical Alert form and a Permission to Administer Medication form may be obtained from the school office.
2. Over-the-Counter medication may not be administered by school staff unless a written note from the child's doctor gives specific dosages and directions. For safety reasons, children may NOT carry over-the-counter medications with them, such as throat lozenges, cough drops, cortisone cream, and the like.

Elk Grove High School Homecoming Parade: Road Closures Affect Pick-up on October 16th!!

Elk Grove High School Homecoming Parade Route Announced

The City of Elk Grove and Elk Grove Unified School District have announced final plans for the annual Elk Grove High School Homecoming Parade route.

To honor the District's 50th anniversary and Grand Marshal Olympian Stephanie Cox-Lopez, the parade will occur on the traditional route on Elk Grove Boulevard from 1:30 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Friday, October 16.

Elk Grove Boulevard will be closed between E. Stockton Boulevard - Emerald Vista Drive and Elk Grove-Florin Rd.

Drivers are encouraged to take the following detours:



Elk Grove Boulevard

- Eastbound traffic will be directed to turn north or south at E. Stockton Boulevard - Emerald Vista Drive
- Westbound traffic will turn right at Elk Grove-Florin Road

Williamson Drive

- Southbound traffic will need to turn right onto Elk Grove Boulevard

Elk Grove-Florin Road will be closed between Valley Oak Lane and Elk Grove Boulevard

- Southbound traffic will need to turn left onto Elk Grove Boulevard
- Northbound traffic will need to make a u-turn at Valley Oak Lane
