

Grade 2 February Goals

Reading

We will understand characters by analyzing their thoughts and actions.

We will identify the facts, opinions and text and graphic features used in an informational text.

We will also use text details to draw conclusions about a text.

Writing

We will begin to write opinion pieces in which students introduce the topic, state an opinion and supply reasons that support the opinion and reasons.

We will use linking words to connect opinion and reasons, and provide a concluding statement.

We will write a persuasive essay on a selected topic. (Writing Reviews)

Math

We will add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.

We will use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve one- and two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing.

Science

We will identify and describe the properties of materials.

We will identify the characteristics of solids, liquids and gases.

Social Studies

We will continue to learn about different types of communities.

Students will compare and contrast these communities on their own. They will use multiple resources to gather information about different types of communities. As a culminating project, students will create a diorama of a chosen community.
