The posters are a demonstration of student understanding of the importance and uses of learning new languages and an excellent project for Hispanic Heritage Month and Foreign Language Celebrations!

### Chapter Poster Contest México: crisol de culturas

#### Requirements:

- 1. Each poster must be created by only one student. Teachers may submit a total of three posters per grade category: K-3, 4-5, 6-8 and 9-12.
- 2. Entries must be 12 x 18 inches and may be drawn in pencil, crayon, pen, ink, paints or markers. This year's theme must be written on the poster: "México: crisol de cuturas" or in Portuguese, "México: crisol de culturas." Students may use a variety of artistic approaches to represent the theme.

Any writing on the poster must be in SPANISH or PORTUGUESE.

- Posters may be in the form of graphic designs, digital illustrations or photographs. may Students use any available design applications/programs. \*\*Save the design into a high resolution format Chapter .jpg NameStudentsFirstname\_Lastname. Each entry must be accompanied by the Student Information Form. Email the jpg image and the Student Form Information **TOGETHER** AMontserrat.aatspmetny@gmail.com
- 4. Posters will be judged on their applicability to the theme, creativity, and uniqueness.
- 5. Sponsoring teachers of students entering the contest must be current AATSP members.
- 6. Each poster must be accompanied by the AATSP student information form which may be duplicated. Please TYPE or PRINT NEATLY information and attach to the back of the entry with tape ON ALL SIDES do not staple!
- 7. Posters must be received by January 28, 2019. Teachers of winning students will be notified by February 28, 2019. Mail posters first class, FLAT, not rolled or folded and protected by cardboard. Mail posters to:

NSE Announces an Additional Option for Testing

Beginning with the 2018-2019 academic year, NSE will provide two options to teachers as follows:

NSE – National Spanish Examinations

All registration and test administration procedures will remain unchanged from 2018.

• NSA – National Spanish Assessments

AATSP announces a new series of examinations called the National Spanish Assessments.

The National Spanish Assessments (NSA) are the non-contest version of the NSE. The NSA is valid assessment tool written from the same specifications and standards as the National Spanish Examinations.

Registration and testing can take place throughout the academic year.

The cost of the NSA is \$3 per student.

Each of the four modules (Interpretive Reading, Interpretive Listening, Vocabulary, and Grammar) can be administered separately.

Each of the four modules can be administered twice and at different points in the year to show growth.

The NSA is not part of the NSE contest, and there are no prizes nor scholarships.

Results are available immediately through the teacher's Quia account.

Results are provided in points and percentages, not in percentiles.

AATSP is currently working with Telefónica Educación Digital to develop the SEAL Exam. This full-proficiency examination combines the NSA exam scores, M1 (Interpretive Reading) and M2 (Interpretive Listening), with the SIELE S5 scores for Presentational Speaking and Writing.

Schools must apply to become testing centers to administer SIELE through the SIELE website.

Approved test centers can administer other SIELE exams in addition to the SEAL exam.

Teachers register for the SEAL exam through the NSE website using ONE online registration form.

The cost of the SEAL Exam is \$89.

Results are generally available within three weeks of testing.

Results are provided as a proficiency using CEFR proficiency levels.

NOTE: Correlation of CEFR levels to ACTFL levels are readily available.

If you registered students for the 2018 National Spanish Examinations, then you are already on our mailing list and will automatically receive updates.

Register Your Students Today! Registration for the 2019 National Spanish Examinations is now open through January 31, 2019.
