Dear Families,

A few reminders.....

- Please call the office by 8:45 AM if your child is going to be absent.

Families of CAR RIDERS:

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE..... Let's keep each other and most especially our dear students safe during car line dismissal.

This exact car dismissal process, designed by **The Bethlehem Police Department**, has worked well for many years. Our staff cares and is working hard in all forms of weather conditions to ensure the safe dismissal of our children.

Follow these rules and directions and mostly be patient as many, many new families learn the system:

1. **FOLLOW ALL** instructions and directions you are given. PLEASE do not argue or to continue to disregard the rules. It is not fair to your children and other families.
2. **NEVER, EVER** park your car on a side or surrounding street to avoid the car line. Crossing and walking in between cars is unsafe and not permitted.
3. This process always takes extra time the first few weeks of school **PLEASE BE PATIENT**. If you are not in the first wave of cars, you will be directed to pull up once the first lines of cars are dismissed.

Again – the safety of our students is our highest priority, and all dismissal rules will be followed and enforced.

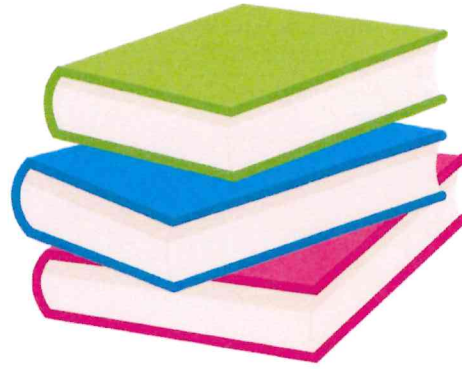
