Dear Parents,

I hope everyone enjoyed a healthy and safe vacation time with families and friends. January is a time where we are almost mid-way through the school year. We have been in school long enough to take stock in how students are acclimating as we move toward the remaining half of the school year.

During the next three weeks students will be assessed to determine the amount of progress they are making. We use several assessments to complete this task. You may hear your child/children talk about these assessments:

- 1. Acadience A universal screening and progress monitoring assessment that measures the acquisition of early literacy skills from Kindergarten through Sixth grade.
- 2. Teachers College Running Record A running record is a tool for coding, scoring and analyzing a child's precise reading behaviors.
- 3. I-Ready Math and Reading A computer adaptive diagnostic and instruction program for both math and reading.

Academic Intervention Services (AIS)

For those students who are currently enrolled in AIS programs, the end date for this first round of programs is Thursday, January 26th. This includes the before and after-school programs. A second round of AIS programs will begin on Monday, January 30th. Many of the students in the first series of AIS will roll into the second, but some will graduate out. We will utilize the data collected from the above referenced assessments to determine if changes need to be made to our AIS programs.

Please be informed that the NYC Health Director has now recommended (but not required) indoor masking in all schools due to the increase in Flu, RSV and COVID-19 cases in schools. PS 3 has a significant inventory of student masks and will provide if necessary.
