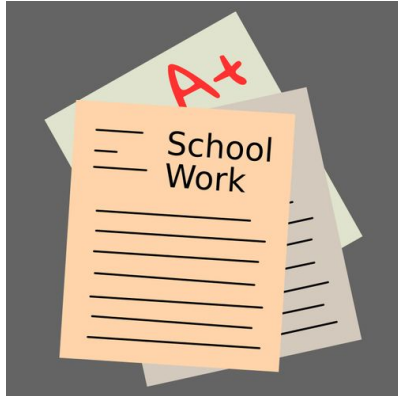

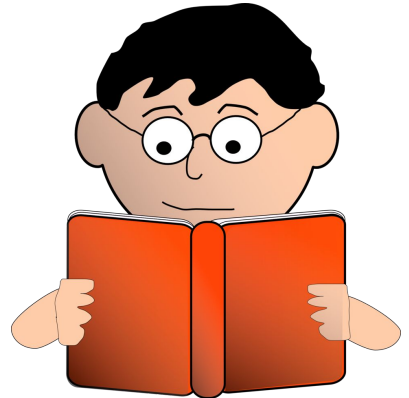
- Due to the fact that we have not had school closures caused by inclement weather this academic year, we have a total of four (4) days banked for emergency school closings.
  - *Two of those days are already built into the school calendar, with two of these days now being taken from our Weather Makeup Day 1, and Weather Makeup Day 2 during the Memorial Day Weekend (5/22/20 and 5/26/20)*
- Teachers will begin to be “on call” from 3/17 - 3/25, and will facilitate “office hours,” for students.
- Teachers will provide feedback to students starting from 3/17 (i.e. Google Classroom, email, etc)

# Signing Into Google Classroom (Review):

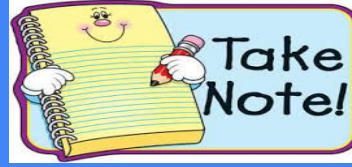
1. Go to **google.com** and click sign in.
2. Enter your username:

(7th grade is [jeterde2025@nredlearn.org](mailto:jeterde2025@nredlearn.org), and 8th grade is [jeterde2024@nredlearn.org](mailto:jeterde2024@nredlearn.org))

3. Click Next.
4. Enter your password: your student ID number.
5. Click Next.
6. At the top right on the screen, click on the 9 gray dots. Go to the Classroom icon (pictured below).
7. Click on the class or join the class you wish to participate in with the Class code provided by your teacher.
