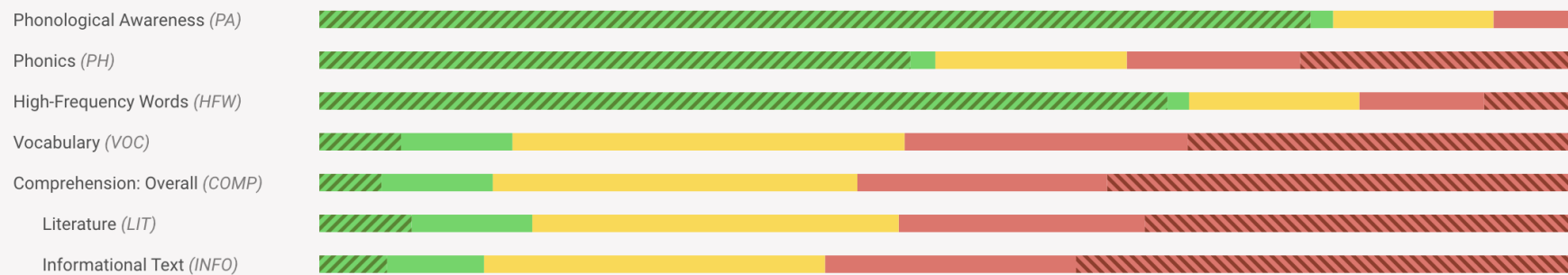
Overall Placement

▼ Placement by Domain



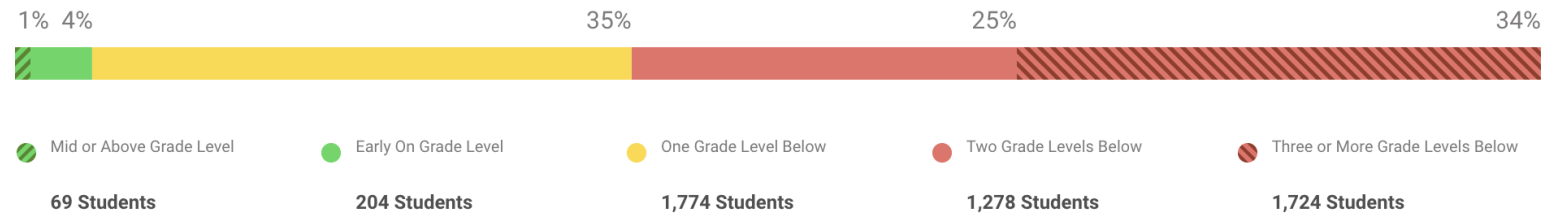
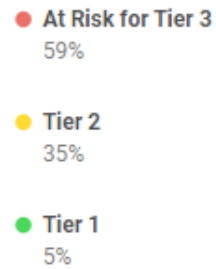

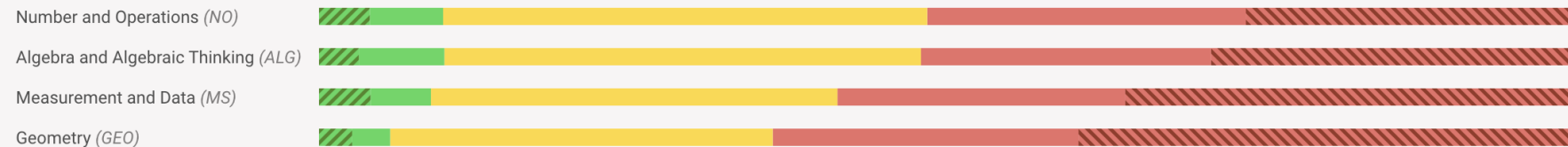

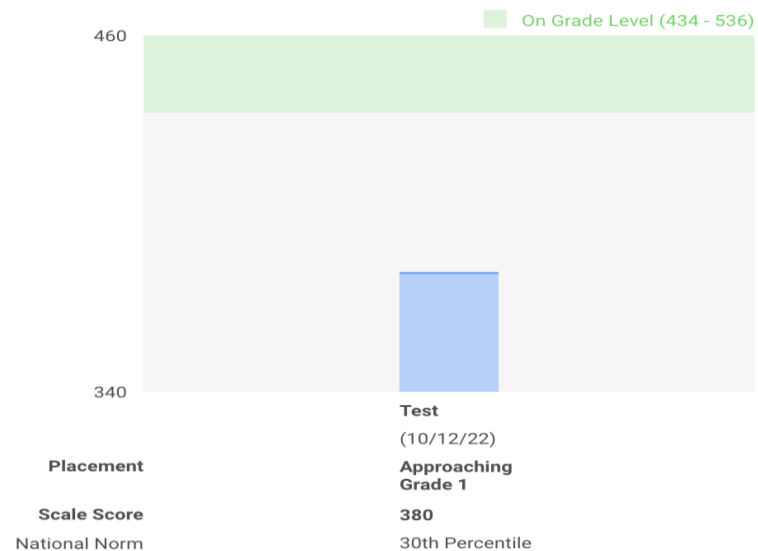

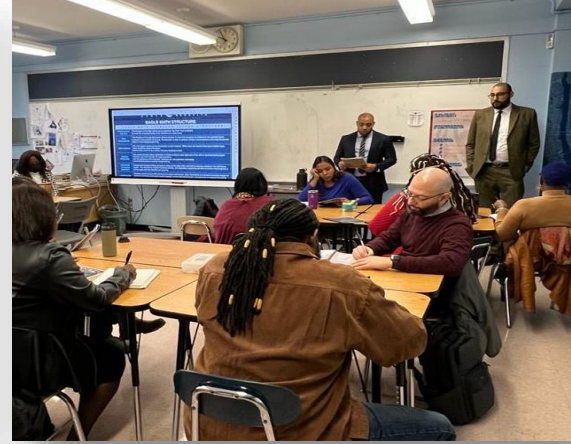

Student Programming & Support

School Finance

- Mid-year adjustment are expected to result in approximately \$200 million increase to school budgets
 - The boost for schools will be supported by stimulus funding
- Schools that would receive additional funding through the mid-year adjustment because of an increase in student enrollment will receive the full increase
 - No school will lose money due to mid-year enrollment losses
