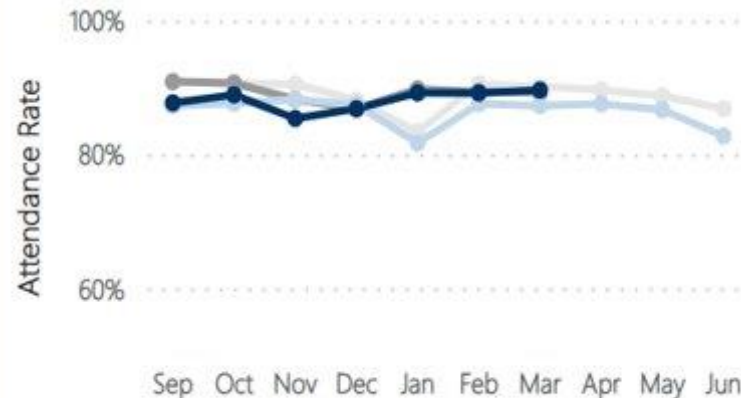

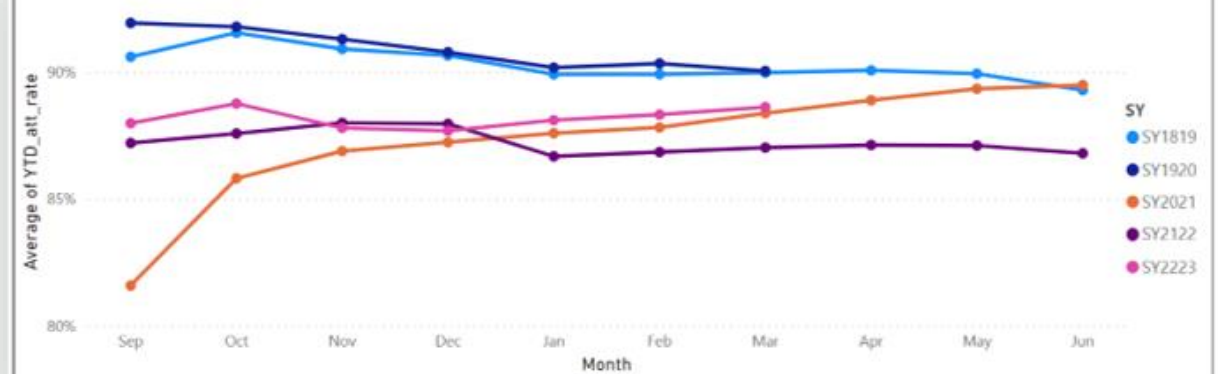

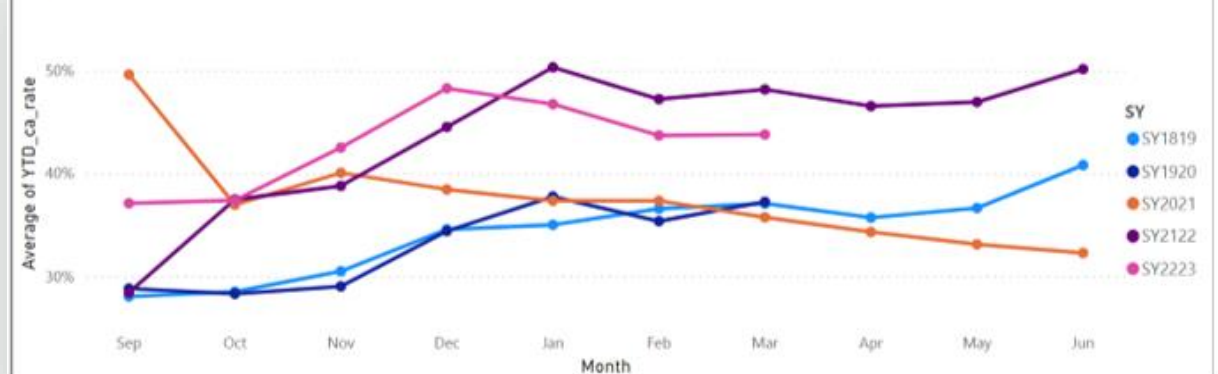

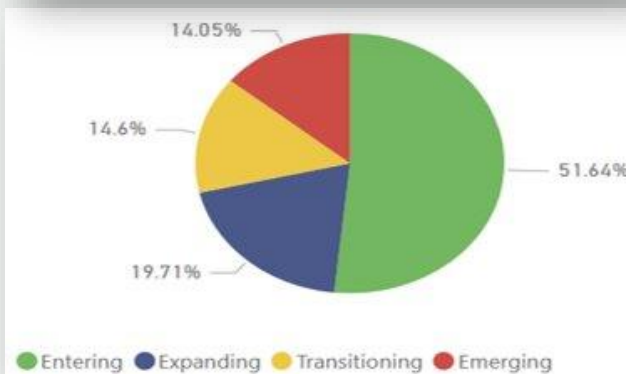

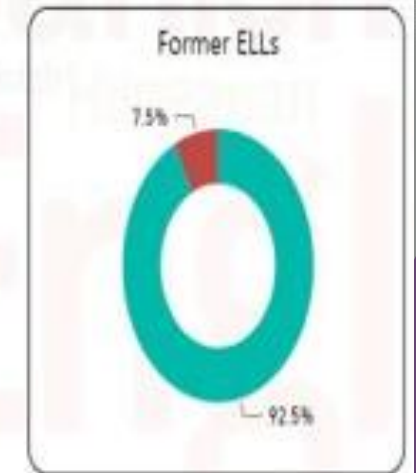

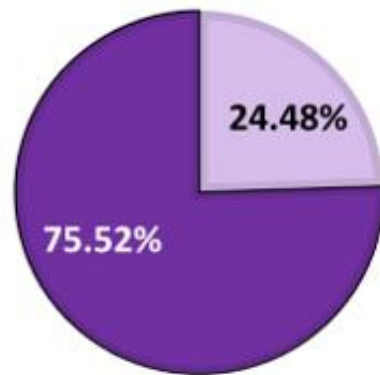

Areas of Focus



Mindful De-Escalation PD, a multi-session crisis prevention, intervention and response workshop with the frame of mindfulness and a focus on self-awareness.



Monthly trainings with the goal of training 2 members from the crisis teams from each school.



District 23 School Crisis Team Trainings
During our School Counselor & Social Worker Community Meetings, participants dedicate time to re-visiting their school's crisis intervention plan and engage in targeted professional development to strengthen and improve upon crisis intervention procedures, protocols, and responses.
